

FLIGHT COMMANDER

The Flight Commander reports directly to his/her Deputy Squadron Commander. The Flight Commanders are responsible for the Deputy Flight commander of their respective flights. In general terms, they are responsible for:

- a. the dress, drill and deportment and discipline in their flight;
- b. informing their superiors of any problems involving their flight;
- c. addressing absenteeism in the flight on a weekly basis for all activities;
- d. attending all activities which involve the flight they are part of;
- e. displaying a high standard of dress at all times;
- f. ensuring all tasks assigned to the flight are performed with due diligence;
- g. motivating the members of their flight;
- h. encouraging members of the flight to take initiative on performing tasks;
- i. ensuring that a phone chain is in place and that all cadets within their flight are phoned each and every week (i.e. Sunday evening for the upcoming Wednesday);
- j. assisting his immediate superiors in performing Squadron related duties;
- k. informing his immediate superior on the progression and performance, as well as attendance of all the members within their flight.
- l. performing any and all other duties as required by his superiors.
