

Section Commander

The section commander reports directly to his/her deputy flight commander. The section commanders are responsible for all cadets and NCO's within their respective sections. In general terms, they are responsible for:

- a. maintaining a high standard of dress, drill in their section;
- b. ensuring proper discipline and deportment is followed at all times;
- c. knowing, in general, the rules and regulations set forth by the Cadet Administrative Training Orders, in terms of dress, deportment and general cadet knowledge;
- d. the phone chain within their section;
- e. displaying a high standard of dress at all times;
- f. participating in all activities involving the section;
- g. conducting regular checks of uniforms, correcting problems and informing the flight deputy commander of problems as well as supply needs upon request;
- h. being a link between the chain of command and the cadets at the lowest level;
- i. maintaining a high level of knowledge about squadron activities among his/her section members, and encouraging them to participate in those activities;
- j. maintaining a high level of knowledge about the air cadet programme, its aims and general rules and regulations among his/her section members;
- k. reporting all section problems and concerns to the flight deputy commander;
- l. instil a high level of morale and esprit de corps within the section;
- m. being a direct contact for his/her section members in terms of the chain of command;
- n. knowing his section members strengths and weaknesses;
- o. taking the place of the flight deputy commander when necessary;
- p. performing any and all other duties required by his/her superiors.
