

**SQUADRON COMMANDER**

The Squadron Commanders are responsible to the Deputy Wing Commander. The Squadron Commanders are responsible for Deputy Squadron Commanders in their respective Squadrons. In general, they are responsible for:

- a. being a member of the Wing Senior NCO's;
- b. the dress, discipline and deportment of all the cadets in their respective squadron;
- c. the social and military activities of their respective squadron;
- d. being a link between the Wing NCO's and all the cadets in their respective squadron;
- e. possessing exemplary dress, drill and deportment at all times;
- f. assisting the Deputy Wing Commander by ensuring that attendance is completed and that all reasons for absence have been noted by the Flight Commanders of their respective squadron;
- g. assisting the Wing Warrant Officer with inspections and the recording of the marks which will go towards Top Flight. Also responsible for the collection of Canadian Tire money from their respective Flight Commanders, which will also go towards Top Flight;
- h. understanding the Manual of Drill and Ceremonial (201) and must be prepared to replace the any of the Wing NCO's in their absence at all times;
- i. reporting to the Deputy Wing Commander any problems, issues or concerns that they are not equipped/capable of solving on their own;
- j. ensuring esprit de corps and morale in their respective Squadrons;
- k. completing a report at the end of the cadet training year, detailing good points, points to improve, activities to complete or not complete for the following year based on your position, make plausible recommendations for the betterment of the entire Wing. This report must be handed in to the Wing Deputy Commander at the end of the cadet training year;
- l. completing all other tasks as requested by the Deputy Wing Commander.
