

The Carignan Scholarship for Future Pilots

The Carignan Scholarship for Future Pilots will be awarded to a cadet of 632 Phoenix Squadron who is passionate about pursuing a career as a pilot. The Scholarship seeks to provide a cadet with extra training hours in order to help them hone in their skills to better prepare them for their future career as pilots. There is no requirement on the type of pilot that you must become only that you are excited and exhilarated by flying.

Candidates for this award must meet the following criteria:

- a) Must have completed the Cadet Power Flying program and hold a valid Pilot License
- b) Must be actively involved in 632 Phoenix Squadron
- c) Must have obtained a high rating in written and flying tests carried out in conjunction with the Flying Scholarship Course
- d) Must have an average of above 80% in their High School Marks
- e) Must have parent or guardian approval (if the applicant is under 18 years of age).

Letters of Recommendation from teachers, commanding officers or prominent members of the community outlining the applicant's achievements may be included along with the completed application form. Please complete the application form on the next page and include it with a short statement of purpose in your application.

The completed application form, including supporting information, must arrive, either by regular email or via email at the addresses shown below, no later than April 30th. Entries received after this date will not be eligible.

Successful applicants will be selected by May 10th and will be invited for an interview shortly thereafter.

The official recipient of the Carignan Scholarship for Future Pilots will be announced at 632 Phoenix Squadron's Annual Ceremonial Parade. Decisions of the committee will be considered final.
